ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
IN RE: FEDERAL LAW CLERK  
POLICY COMMITTEE

As the legal community in South Florida continues to grow and prosper, this Court has become aware of the increasing recruiting pressures which are being experienced by law firms in the Southern District of Florida. In order to ensure that the law clerks employed by the Judges of this Court have an appropriate opportunity to participate in law firm recruiting and in order to ensure that the recruiting of law clerks does not affect or interrupt their functions with this Court, the Judges of this Court have determined that it would be desirable to create uniform standards with regard to recruitment of law clerks from the Southern District of Florida.

Accordingly, it is herewith ORDERED that the Federal Law Clerk Policy Committee be created to recommend to the Judges of this Court appropriate standards with respect to law clerk recruiting. The committee shall consist of the following:


