ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: NO. 89-10

In re: Transfer of Cases :
to the Middle District of :
Florida Pursuant to the Act :

The Judicial Improvements and Access to Justice Act signed by President Ronald Reagan on November 19, 1988 transferred Collier, Glades and Hendry Counties from the Southern District of Florida to the Middle District of Florida.

To effectuate an orderly transfer of cases, counsel was afforded an opportunity to waive trial by jury in the Middle District of Florida and have their cases remain in the Southern District of Florida. The Court instructed the Clerk of Court to mail individual waivers to counsel in those case where a jury demand was requested. Upon the expiration of the required return date for the waivers, the Clerk prepared a listing reflecting those cases where counsel elected not to waive jury in the Middle District. Therefore, it is


