
When the Civil Category A assignment wheel was constituted on January 12, 1990, a number of Southern Division Judges' ballots were included in the Northern assignment deck to provide sufficient ballots for the estimated assignment needs of the Northern Division. However, because of an unanticipated increase in Southern Civil Category A assignment activity in the first two months of 1990, the Southern Division assignment deck is nearing depletion while the Northern Division assignment deck still contains a large number of ballots.

Due to the randomness of the automated case assignment system, the Northern Judges could receive an excessive number of Southern assignments if the Southern Division assignment deck should deplete entirely. Therefore, the Clerk is hereby,

ORDERED to shift all remaining Southern Division Judge ballots contained in the Northern Category A deck into the Southern Category A deck for assignment to Southern Division cases. This action in no way changes to actual number of assignment ballots originally assigned to each Judge in the present wheel.
