ORDERED that fourteen new Federal Grand Juries be empaneled on the dates as set forth below:

- February 24, 1993 - one grand jury for Narcotics Section which replaces 91-1(KW).
- March 08, 1993 - one grand jury for Narcotics Section which replaces 91-7(MIA).
- March 15, 1993 - one grand jury for Special Invest. Section which replaces 91-8(MIA).
- March 22, 1993 - one grand jury for Organized Crime Section which replaces 91-2(MIA).
- April 12, 1993 - one grand jury for Special Invest. Section which replaces 91-11(MIA).
- April 19, 1993 - one grand jury for Narcotics Section which replaces 91-10(MIA).
- April 26, 1993 - one grand jury for Public Integrity Section which replaces 91-9(MIA).
- June 07, 1993 - one grand jury for Narcotics Section which replaces 91-12(MIA).
- September 27, 1993 - one grand jury for Economic Crimes which replaces 92-1(MIA).

Central Region

November 08, 1993 - one grand jury for Fort Lauderdale
which replaces 92-1(FL).

December 13, 1993 - one grand jury for Fort Lauderdale
which replaces 92-2(FL).

Northern Region

March 15, 1993 - one grand jury for West Palm Beach
which replaces 91-1(WPB).

May 03, 1993 - one grand jury for West Palm Beach
which replaces 91-2(WPB).

These new Federal Grand Juries will replace the following
seventeen that will be discharged during calendar year 1993:

92-1(FL), 92-2(FL), 91-1(WPB), 91-2(WPB), 91-3(WPB), 91-1(KW),
91-2(MIA), 91-4(MIA), 91-6(MIA), 91-7(MIA), 91-8(MIA), 91-9(MIA),
91-10(MIA), 91-11(MIA), 91-12(MIA), 91-13(MIA), and 92-1(MIA).


