

On June 1, 2000, Thomas E. Scott resigned from his appointment as United States Attorney for the Southern District of Florida.

Effective June 2, 2000, United States Attorney General Janet Reno appointed Assistant United States Attorney Guy A. Lewis to a 120-day term as United States Attorney for the Southern District of Florida, pursuant to Title 28, United States Code § 546(c)(2).

In light of the expiration of the appointment of United States Attorney Guy A. Lewis on September 29, 2000, and because there is no current nomination pending before the United States Senate to fill this vacancy,

**IT IS ORDERED**, effective 12:01 a.m., September 30, 2000, pursuant to Title 28, United States Code § 546(d), that Guy A. Lewis, Esquire, be and he is hereby appointed United States Attorney for the Southern District of Florida.
