

MAGISTRATE JUDGE ROBERT L. DUBÉ



Pursuant to Administrative Order 2003-111, which changed the Miami Magistrate Judge pairing plan, Judge Robert L. Dubé is now the assigned Magistrate Judge on all Social Security appeals assigned to Miami Judges. Consistent with that new assignment, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that each Miami District Judge may cause to be transferred from the currently assigned Magistrate Judge to Judge Dubé a maximum of three pending Social Security cases by entering a transfer order designating the case or cases to be transferred. Cases which are fully briefed and ready for disposition, or in which the parties have consented to Magistrate Judge jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(C)(1) are not eligible for transfer.
