It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has disbarred the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida, effective, nunc pro tunc, November 17, 2002, following a December 18, 2003, order. On April 28, 2004, Mr. Hollander was served by mail with an Order to Show Cause why this Court should not impose the same discipline, accompanied by the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Disbarment. As of the date of this Order, more than 45 days have passed with no response from Mr. Hollander. Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, it is ORDERED that said attorney be disbarred from practice in this Court, effective, nunc pro tunc, November 17, 2002, following the December 18, 2003, Supreme Court of Florida order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of the Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court mail Bruce Lee Hollander a copy of this Order of Disbarment.
