

IN RE: PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT  
OF LIJYASU MAHOMET KANDEKORE

This cause comes before the Court upon Lijyasu Mahomet Kandekore's Petition for Reinstatement to this Court's Bar. His petition was referred to the Ad Hoc Committee on Attorney Admissions, Peer Review, and Attorney Grievance. After a hearing, at which Mr. Kandekore appeared, and further briefing, the Committee issued a report recommending that Mr. Kandekore's Petition for Reinstatement be denied.

Having reviewed Mr. Kandekore's Petition and all related documents, the transcript of the hearing held before the Committee, and the Committee's Report and Recommendation in light of this Court's Rules Governing Attorney Discipline and Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys, the Court finds that Mr. Kandekore does not qualify for readmission to the Bar of this Court. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Mr. Kandekore's Petition for Reinstatement is DENIED.
