

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2004-42

IN RE: EXEMPTION OF FEES FOR PROFESSOR
GILLIAN HADFIELD TO ACCESS PACER



The United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida maintains case information online with the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) website. The Court desires to encourage the public's use of the data base and to continue to promote public access and to avoid unreasonable burdens on both users and court staff in retrieving data. Therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that in accordance with the Miscellaneous Fee Schedule promulgated under 28 U.S.C. § 1913, 1914, 1926, and 1930, for the purpose of clarifying the judiciary's policy with respect to granting exemptions from electronic public access fees prescribed under those schedules, Professor Gillian Hadfield is hereby exempt from the prescribed fees for electronic access in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to such information for a period commencing upon entry of this order and concluding November 1, 2005.

The Clerk of Court for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, shall provide the PACER Service

Center with any detailed information the Center may require to implement this Order.
