




Pursuant to the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, Section 4.02.00, the district judges may select one full-time magistrate judge to serve as the chief magistrate judge performing administrative functions. Inasmuch as the Court established a schedule to rotate the position of chief magistrate judge based on seniority in March 1994, and appearing that Magistrate Judge Ted E. Bandstra is next due to assume the position of Chief Magistrate Judge, it is

**ORDERED** that Magistrate Judge Ted E. Bandstra is hereby appointed as Chief Magistrate Judge vice Magistrate Judge Ann E. Vitunac.

Magistrate Judge Bandstra's appointment as Chief Magistrate Judge shall be for a three-year term effective April 10, 2006, pursuant to AO 2006-09.
