

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2010-107

**IN RE: CONSUMER BANKRUPTCY EXTERNSHIP
CLINIC OF FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL
UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF LAW**



THIS MATTER is before the Court upon the request for certification of the Consumer Bankruptcy Externship Clinic of Florida International University College of Law (the "CBEC"). Pursuant to Rule 6 of this Court's *Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys*, this request was referred to the Ad Hoc Committee on Attorney Admissions, Peer Review, and Attorney Grievance to determine their eligibility for certification.

Having reviewed the Committee's Report and Recommendation, the request, and the materials submitted by the law school in support of certification, the Court agrees with the Committee that the program satisfies the requirements of Rule 6 of the *Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys*. The CBEC seeks to provide free legal services to persons who need representation and guidance in consumer bankruptcy matters. The program is a "law school clinical program for credit" as described in Rule 6(c)(1) and is open only to those law students who meet the requirements of Rule 6(b). All other requirements of Rule 6 are addressed and satisfied by the program description in the application. Therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the program is hereby certified by the Court under Rule 6(c) of the *Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys*. Pursuant to Rule 6(d) of these Rules, Leyza F. Blanco, Esq. is hereby certified as supervising attorney. It is further

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the future certification of students enrolled in the CBEC and other supervising attorneys shall be conditioned upon the filing with this Court of the certifications described in, and required by, Rule 6(e) of the *Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys*, and approval of such certifications by the Court.
