ORDER OF SUSPENSION

It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has disbarred the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida, effective *nunc pro tunc*, October 22, 2007, following a September 18, 2008, order. That disbarment was predicated upon a guilty plea and conviction in this Court. Thereafter, the Clerk attempted to serve Mr. Seitel by certified mail with an Order to Show Cause why this Court should not impose the same discipline, accompanied by the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Disbarment, which was returned as not deliverable. Other attempts to serve Mr. Seitel have not been successful. Rule IVA of the Southern District of Florida Attorney Discipline Rules provides in pertinent part: "Upon the filing with this court of a certified copy of a judgement of conviction demonstrating that any attorney admitted to practice...has been convicted...of any serious crime...the Court shall enter an order immediately suspending that attorney... . That suspension so ordered shall remain in effect until final disposition of the disciplinary proceedings to be commenced upon such conviction." Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida,

IT IS ORDERED that said attorney be suspended from practice in this Court, effective immediately until final disposition of the attorney discipline proceedings to be commenced upon his conviction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall strike Loel H. Seitel from the roll

of attorneys for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida. The Clerk shall also immediately revoke Mr. Seitel's CM/ECF password.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of the Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court shall serve by certified mail a copy of this Order of Suspension upon the attorney at his court record address.
