




ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Jorge Luis Suarez's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. Suarez was reciprocally disciplined by this Court based upon an Order of Suspension by the Supreme Court of Florida as the result of a Conditional Guilty Plea for Consent Judgment entered between the attorney and The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar v. Suarez*, 139 So.3d 301 (Fla. 2014). On June 19, 2014, Suarez filed a Petition for Reinstatement with The Florida Bar. After consideration of a report of the referee, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement on September 29, 2014, reinstating Suarez as a member in good standing with The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar v. Suarez*, No. SC-14-1196, 2014 WL 4826693 (Fla. Sept. 29, 2014).

Pursuant to Rule 9(d) of this Court's Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, having reviewed the Petition, attachments to the Petition, and being otherwise fully advised, the Court GRANTS the Petition for Reinstatement and finds that Mr. Suarez qualifies for readmission to this Court's Bar. The Court further orders that Petitioner be reinstated as a member in good standing to the Bar of this Court.
