ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-86

IN RE: PAYMENT OF GARNISHMENT DEPOSIT
TO GARNISHEE

Effective July 1, 2014, Florida Statute section 77.28 was amended to require the party applying for a writ of garnishment to “pay \$100 to the garnishee” instead of into the registry of the Court. See Ch. 2014-211, § 3, Laws of Fla. Administrative Orders 90-104, 98-51, and 2001-69, and Local Rule 67.1(c) provide procedures instructing the party applying for a writ of garnishment to deposit the sum of \$100 into the registry of the Court before a writ of garnishment can be issued pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 69, thereby implementing Florida Statute section 77.28. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that any party applying for a writ of garnishment should no longer pay \$100 into the Court registry and should instead make that payment to the garnishee, under the newly amended section 77.28, Florida Statutes. This Order supersedes Administrative Orders 90-104, 98-51, and 2001-69 in their entirety, which are hereby repealed. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that to avoid any discrepancy between the amended version of section 77.28, Florida Statutes, and Local Rule 67.1(c) of this District, the changes to the payment of the garnishment deposit set forth above shall be effective immediately and the Clerk shall suspend collection of the \$100 deposit under Local Rule 67.1(c) until such

amendments can be made to the Local Rules.
